### Ewing Free School Launched

Ewing, NJ, March 14, 2010 — To provide our local community a means to share knowledge, skills, and/or experience *for free*, Ewing Free School has been launched.

The school organizes various activities (classes/courses, group activities, etc.) run by facilitators (teachers or coordinators) joined by participants (students or group members). In practice, what the school organizer (administrator) does is simply lists activities on the school's web site. The other things will be arranged by the facilitators. As a starter, the school is in touch with potential facilitators for the following activities: meditation, cooking, computers, household troubleshooting, self publishing, and more. The school welcomes people not only in/near Ewing, NJ, but also from other areas, possibly through on-line communication.

The school operates in the spirit of *Beacon Hill Free School* (as described in John Holt's *Instead of Education*, 1976). As long as no safety/regulatory issues are involved, anyone can facilitate activities and anyone can participate in them. Since the school has no physical space, facilitators will use free public space, e.g., meeting rooms at local libraries, as well as their own space and cyberspace (i.e., on-line). In fact, the school has absolutely no budget. Furthermore, it is a "free" school also in the sense that it is not controlled by obligation or the will of another.
